

Seeing Sepsis: Early Detection Saves Lives

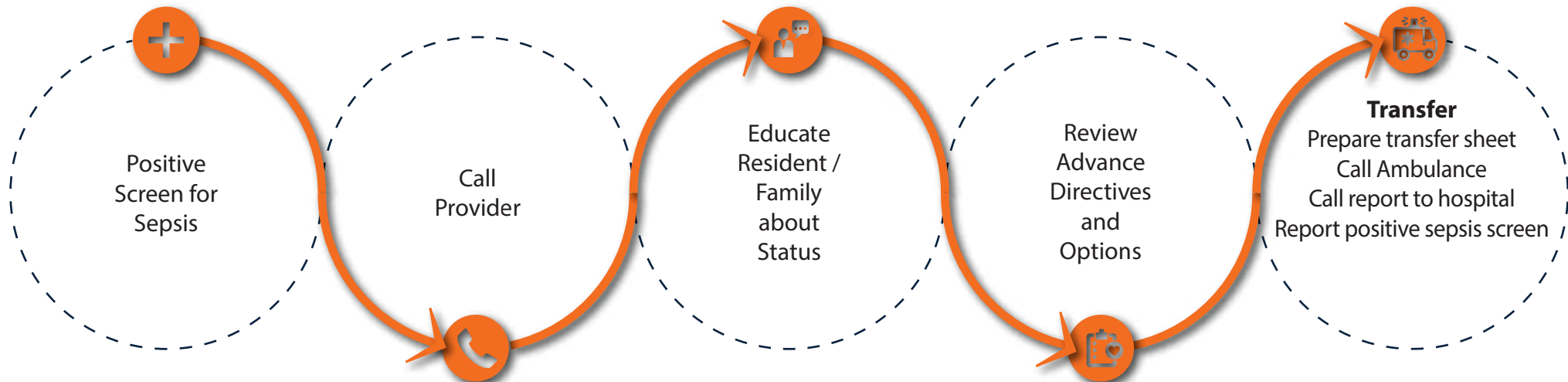
Sepsis happens when an infection you already have - in your skin, lungs, urinary tract, or somewhere else - triggers a life-threatening chain reaction through your body.

Signs & Symptoms

- Pulse ≥ 100
- BP < 100 or > 40 mmHg from baseline
- Temp ≥ 100.0 or ≤ 96.8
- Respiratory rate > 20 /SpO₂ $< 90\%$
- Altered mental status

ACT FAST

Get medical care IMMEDIATELY if you suspect sepsis or there is an infection that's not getting better or is getting worse.
